

How many lights should I put in? What is a Lumen? How bright is the light?

As a rule of thumb and in approximation:

One LED is equal to a 10-Watt incandescent bulb in brightness.

One LED light is approximately equal to a 60 Watt incandescent because it has 6 LEDs in it.

A lumen is a unit of measurement for light.

A standard 60-Watt incandescent is 900 lumens of omni directional light and 6 LEDs offer over 600 lumens of directional light.
